Race and Ethnicity	<p>Element 3.04</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Add "Hispanic/Latina/e/o" to response options • Add "Middle Eastern or North African" to 3.04 • Removes 3.05 Ethnicity (see Retired Elements below)
Gender	<p>Element 3.06</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Change "Male/Female" to "Man (if child, Boy)/Woman (if child, Girl)" • Change "Gender other than..." to "Non-Binary" • Add "Culturally specific identity" and "different identity"
Exit Destination	<p>Element 3.12</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Separates Temporary/Permanent Situations response options • Options are re-organized and numbered
Enrollment CoC	<p>Element 3.16</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Change "Client Location" to "Enrollment CoC" • Change data collection stage to project start (only)
Living Situation	<p>Appendix A <i>(Includes Destination 3.12, Prior 3.917, Current 4.12)</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Combines subsidy types in permanent situations into "rent/own by client with ongoing subsidy" • Add dependency that allows for selection of subsidy
Translation Assistance Needed/Language	<p>Element C4 Identifies clients needing translation assistance and specific language</p> <p>Appendix Most common options within HMIS implementation will be added for system use, with "Other" text field</p>
Retired Elements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 3.05 Ethnicity • C1 Wellbeing • V5 Last permanent address • U1 Worst Housing Situation
